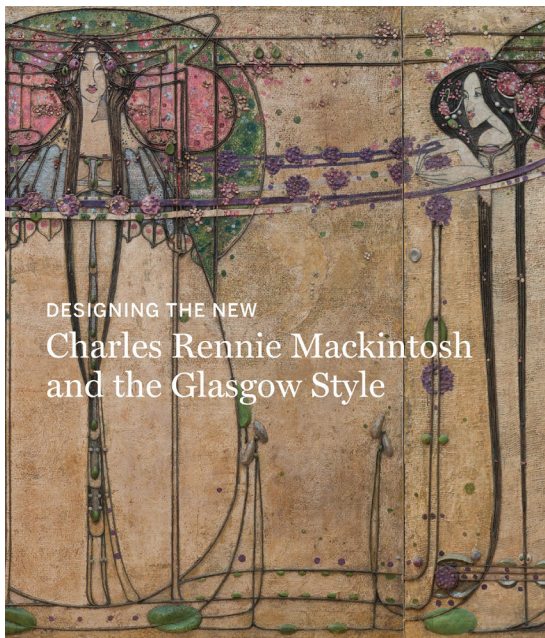

## **Designing the New: Charles Rennie Mackintosh and Glasgow Style**



Andrew Connors, Director of the Albuquerque Museum, will be our guide through the 166 works that comprise the exhibition, the largest ever assembled in the United States.

Mackintosh and his colleagues developed the Glasgow style evidenced in furniture, ceramics, books, textiles, stained glass and painting and drawing, among other art forms, between the 1890s and 1914.

During that era, Glasgow was a center of industrialization but the style that Mackintosh and his colleagues developed emphasized handmade objects.

Art Nouveau as well as Japanese and Persian arts were among the influences that affected the development of the Glasgow style that the works on display will make apparent.
